All residents, eighteen years of age and older must file a city tax return each year. We have made provisions to exempt certain individuals who are at least 60 years of age and receive only nontaxable income.

Nontaxable income includes pensions, annuities, interest, dividends, various forms of public assistance, alimony, permanent disability payments, social security, disbursement of 401-K's and other similar retirement incomes.

Taxable income includes rental properties, farm income, gambling and lottery winnings, part time jobs such as transporting cars, child care, and any other types of part time or full time work.

Disbursements from Sub Chapter S corporations are taxable to Botkins, Fort Loramie, Minster, New Bremen, New Knoxville, Russia and St Marys.

If all of your income comes from nontaxable sources you can apply for the exemption by completing the information below and returning it to our office along with a copy of the front page of your Federal 1040. We will mail a letter of exemption to you if you are fully qualified.

If you receive any taxable income, you cannot be exempted. Please call us with any questions you may have.
