

CITY OF ST. MARYS SPRING CLEAN-UP 2020
(Includes Only City Residential Homes Currently On City Refuse Service)

Monday, October 5th

Curb pickup only for residents whose normal trash day is Thursday.

Monday, October 12th

Curb pickup only for residents whose normal trash day is Tuesday.

Monday, October 19th

Curb pickup only for residents whose normal trash day is Monday or Wednesday.

NOTE: Monday residents, place your normal trash away from clean-up items.

Spring Clean-up items must be at the curb by 6:00 a.m. Monday morning. We will pick up **one time** at your residence. If items are not picked up on your scheduled Monday, please leave out and we will get items the next day.

Because of escalating costs, landfill restrictions, and use of packer trucks for collection, the following regulations and prohibited items will be strictly enforced.

- If items with glass, i.e., doors and windows, can't be packed without glass being ejected from the packer, they won't be collected.
- For spring clean-up items only. Bags will be checked. Normal household garbage must be set out on your weekly collection day.
- Each resident will be limited to a maximum of 60 cubic feet of discards. This is equal to the amount that can be put into the hopper of the collection truck at one time.
- **Items must be bagged, boxed or tied in bundle to be handled by one person. Loose materials not boxed, bagged, or bundled will not be picked up. Due to COVID 19, this will be strictly enforced.**
- Building materials (wood, etc.) must be boxed, bagged or bundled and not exceed 2' x 2'. (no skids)
A full sheet of any product is not accepted. Example: 4' x 8'
- Limit ONE (1) large item per household. For example: chair, recliner, TV, dresser, couch.
- Any rain soaked items that cannot be taken to the truck without falling apart will not be collected.
- No call backs for special items left out on wrong date, put out too late, or too much debris.
- Please place metal materials in pile for metal collectors.
- Cans/barrels used to bundle items will also be discarded as trash.
- Do not place items to be collected in front of parked vehicles.

An effort should be made to keep our community looking neat. PLEASE do not place items out more than 24 hours (1 day) prior to your pickup day. Any resident with trash lying out before the Sunday prior to their pick-up date could be cited. The City and/or contractors shall not accept responsibility for lost or misplaced items.
